APPLICATION FOR NAME ENGRAVING

Any deceased person who directly participated in a commercial fishery in Alaska, or any Alaskan who participated in a commercial fishery as a fisherman or -woman, is eligible to have their name engraved on the Wall. Final eligibility is determined by the Memorial Board. Discrimination of any kind does not play a role in eligibility determinations. Applications should come from legal next-of-kin, or have their demonstrable blessing.

Engravings are limited to any combination of the deceased(s)'s name(s), vessel name(s), date of birth, and date of death. If the deceased was lost at sea (never found), or died at sea (on the water, but was found), a small star may be added after their name.

Each engraving may have a maximum of two lines, 28 characters per line (including spaces and punctuation). Engravings are left-justified and in all-capital letters. Examples:

OLAV HANSEN

HILDA J. HANSEN, 1920-2013
F/V FALCON, ALBATROSS

OLAV HANSEN JR., F/V FALCON ★
1920 - 2013

HILDA "NORDY" HANSEN
MAY 1920 - JUN. 2013

Family members may be combined in a single inscription if both persons are eligible:

HILDA & OLAV HANSEN
F/V FALCON, ALBATROSS

If you wish, you may send in articles or pictures of the deceased, and we will maintain the information in a notebook established for this purpose.

NOTE: For technical reasons beyond our control, engravings typically occur in June, *after* our annual ceremony. A new name is dedicated at the first ceremony following the approval of an application, and noted *again* at the first ceremony following the actual engraving. Names are not always engraved every year due to cost (\$600 does not always cover the expense). If, by mid-May, too few names have been approved, we will not be able to engrave until the next summer. Names should be submitted by the end of April to be in the ceremony, and by late May to be engraved this year.

*Towards the cost of engraving (time, equipment shipping, engraver's airfare), which sometimes are higher and covered by additional donations.
