NOTE TO PARTICIPATING SKIPPERS

Assemble in front of the Memorial by 10:00. San Juan will be at Customs Dock. They will cast off, be first to be blessed, lay the wreath, then exit to the Channel. Next closest vessel should circle past to be blessed, exit, and so forth. Rafting up inside the dock, tied to D-rings, is an option.
